Those parties arriving more than 15 minutes after the actual commencement of the briefing will not be allowed to sign the Attendance Register. Prospective tenderers that do not attend the compulsory clarification meeting will not be allowed to tender and will be viewed as non – complaint.

Completed sealed bids and supporting documents , addressed to the Municipal Manager and marked with **“Description of the project and the bid number”** must be deposited in the Bid box situated at Sakhisizwe Municipal offices ERF 5556, UMthatha Road, Cala, not later than 18th August 2021, @ 12H00. at which the tenders will be opened in public

### N.B The following supporting documentation is to be included in the tender submission:

- Certified copies of original company registration and certified ID documents of members, failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- Confirmation from SARS.
- Bidders must be registered with the CIDB in a CE class of construction works. (CIDB CRS numbers to be submitted with tender).
- Letter of Good Standing issued by the Compensations Commissioner.
- Health and Safety Plan in accordance with provided specification will be requested
- The bid will be evaluated according to the preferential procurement model in the Preferential Procurement the bidders attention is drawn to Form MBD 6.1 whereby bidders other than EMEs must submit their original and valid B-BBEE Status level verification certificate or certified copy thereof, substantiating B-BBEE rating issued by a Registered Auditor approved IRBA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS, EMEs must submit a sworn affidavit. Failure to do so will result in zero points score for BBBEE status level;

- Consolidated B-BBEE certificates for all joint ventures and consortiums
- Signed joint venture agreements(Where applicable)
- Failure to complete all tender forms, data sheets and submit all supplementary information will lead to the tender being considered non-responsive.
- All municipal rates and taxes of the renderer must be paid where the business has its head or regional office and rates clearance certificate not older than 3 months must be submitted with the bid, if the property is being leased by the bidder then lease agreement should be submitted.
- All prospective service providers of goods and services and infrastructure procurement are required to apply on Central Supplier Database in order to do business with all organs of the State in the Republic of South Africa at <https://secured.csd.gov.za> non registration will be regarded as non-responsive and be disqualified from the bid.
